Day 3 | Amman - Jerash – Ajloun Castle – Umm Qais - Amman

Journey north from Amman with your expert guide to the Roman ruins of Jerash – one of the best-preserved provincial cities of the Roman Empire. Walk its colonnaded avenues, climb the steps of its majestic temples, and envision daily life in the ancient Decapolis.

Continue into the highlands to explore Ajloun Castle, a 12th-century Islamic fortress built to defend against the Crusaders. Set atop rolling hills and framed by olive groves, the castle provides both historical depth and panoramic views over the Jordan Valley. Later, travel onward to Umm Qais, a site rich with Greco-Roman ruins and stunning vistas overlooking the Sea of Galilee and Golan Heights. Here, the timeless landscapes invite moments of reflection and shared discovery among the group. At the site, enjoy lunch at a charming local restaurant with panoramic views – where a selection of authentic Levantine dishes offers a flavorful introduction to the region's culinary traditions. Day 4 | Amman – Mount Nebo – Madaba – Kerak Castle – Petra by Night – Petra
